Dundee Hills Incline

Winemaking

Aged on lees for 10 months in neutral French Oak barrels. Coopers include Atelier Centre France, Taransaud, and François Frères. We practice native primary and secondary barrel fermentation for all our Chardonnay, embracing the micro-biome present in our vineyard sites.

Notes

The Incline Chardonnay comes from a rockier, riper section of our Dundee Hills vineyard. Tonally parallel to our Iron Filbert, this slightly elevated ripeness creates a rounder textural quality in the wine and an overall fruitier profile. Pure and precise aromatics of mango, river rock, and lemongrass transition seamlessly into a supple and generous palate full of ripe citrus and slatey mineral definition. This wine is just entering a prime drinking window that should continue for the next 8 years.
