Winemaking

Aged on lees for 11 months in neutral French Oak barrels. Coopers include Atelier Centre France, Taransaud, and François Frères. We practice native primary and secondary fermentations, embracing the micro-biome present in our vineyard sites. Produced with 21 days of skin contact, with very minimal extraction to keep the wines elegant.

Notes

Bursting red aromatics – strawberry, rose petal – are tempered by yeasted pain de mie, toasted brown sugar, and ripe stems. This is a far more accessible rendition of our Dundee Hills estate than the Iron Filbert bottling, with silky tannins and a concentration of sweet red fruit that – although not without aging potential –practically begs for consumption in the near term.
