# Iron Filbert Vineyard

## Winemaking

Aged on lees for 11 months in neutral French Oak barrels. Coopers include Atelier Centre France, Taransaud, and François Frères. We practice native primary and secondary fermentations, embracing the micro-biome present in our vineyard sites. Produced with 21 days of skin contact, with very minimal extraction to keep the wines elegant.

## Notes

In 2019, our Dundee Hills vineyard-designate opens with a surge of blood orange, candied hibiscus, and wild raspberry, balanced and restrained by savory oolong tea. Raspberry persists on the medium-weight palate, which gains dimension with precise notes of rosehip and iron that escort a concentrated and lengthy finish. This an elegant wine that should age gracefully for 12+ years of enjoyment.
