Winemaking

Aged on lees for 11 months in neutral French Oak barrels. Coopers include Atelier Centre France, Taransaud, and François Frères. We practice 100% native primary and secondary fermentations, embracing the micro-biome present in our vineyard sites. Produced with an average of 15 days of skin contact, with very minimal extraction to keep the wines elegant.

Notes

This wine is youthful, vibrant, and bright. Hood strawberry, jasmine, black pepper, and iron shine aromatically. The palate is light on its feet with tons of ripe red fruit and juicy, bright acid. A true profile showcasing the ripe fruit predominantly from the south end of our Iron Filbert Vineyard.
