Winemaking

Our 2021 Dundee Hills Incline Pinot Noir is sourced from our Iron Filbert Vineyard in the Dundee Hills. It consists largely of Pommard clones. The final blend is a combination of stainless and concrete ferments with an average of 16 days on skins before pressing. 100% native, spontaneous fermentation. 40% whole cluster. Aged 11 months on lees in 20% new oak – 10% new Taransaud French oak barrels and 10% new Kádár Hungarian oak barrels.

Notes

The 2021 Dundee Hills Incline Pinot Noir opens with spirit, showing bright raspberry, blueberry, and baking spices reminiscent of holiday festivities. Supple red fruit and bright, lively acidity carry a great energy through the core of the wine. The palate is approachable yet refined, an earlier drinker that will continue to age well for 8-10 years. 14.5% ALC.
